Homeowners' Association Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the Homeowners' Association will be held on Wednesday, April 24th at 7:00 p.m. at the Upper Dublin Library at 520 Virginia Drive in Fort Washington. We will be discussing our upcoming Spring projects which include new street lighting and parking spot painting. We encourage you to attend. Three homeowners will be elected (or reelected) to the Board of Directors. New Street lighting

New light fixtures will be installed throughout the community. The existing light posts are beat up due to age and being struck by lawn mowers and other landscaping equipment. The new street lights are much nicer looking than the existing ones, will all be the same style, take LED lights to keep the electrical cost low and are designed to project light down and outward which should provide more uniform lighting throughout the community.

Parking Spot Repainting

All of the parking spots of residents and visitor parking will be repainted. Over the years due to wear and snow plowing the numbers and letters are wearing off. There will be no changes to locations. Contractors are coming in May to do the work and will need homeowners' assistance to move their cars for the entire day while their street is being painted. Be on the lookout for letters and emails with specific dates and times as it gets closer.

Resident Work Truck Parking

Homeowners voted to amend the declaration to permit work trucks that residents drive to and from work each day to park in one of their assigned parking spots. The vehicle must be small enough to fit in the assigned spot and if the assigned spot is in front of another resident's house the vehicle must be parked in a visitor parking spot. The amendment is effective immediately.

Parking in Arrowhead

Houses in Arrowhead have assigned parking spots reserved for residents of the house. Parking in those spots by other persons is not permitted, except when permission is given by the resident. If you are having visitors or contractors at your house notify them in advance to parking in the visitor parking spots. Parking in any area other than an assigned or visitor spot is not permitted.



Trash Collection on Township Holidays When a township holiday is on a Monday trash and recycling for Arrowhead will be collected on Wednesday. The following are Monday township holidays for 2024: MLK Day (1/15), Presidents' Day (2/19), Memorial Day (5/27), Labor Day (9/2) and Columbus Day (10/14)



Cardboard Recycling – Township Requirements

Cardboard should be flattened and placed in the recycling container (not outside the container) on trash day, unless you have scheduled an extra pick up.



Extra Cardboard Pick Up

If you have scheduled an extra cardboard pickup, the cardboard outside the container should be flattened and tied together. To schedule an extra cardboard pickup, call the township – 215-643-1600.



Yard Waste

Yard waste collection is each Thursday beginning on March 7th and ends on November 21th. There is no collection on Thanksgiving Day (Thursday 11/28). Waste must be in a container (not a trash or recycling one) or yard waste paper bags. Place containers and bags in the normal trash and recycling container location the night before collection day and return containers by Thursday evening or early Friday morning.



Bulk Trash Pick Ups

The township will pick up large trash items for a small fee. Call 215-643-1600 to schedule a pick up. The bulk trash pick-up day is Wednesday.



Shredding for Township Residents

Shredding - Saturday, April 6th and Saturday, September 21st from 8 to 10 am at the township building, 370 Commerce Drive. Limit of 3 bags per car.




Electronic Waste Collection for Township Residents

HOUSE EXTERIOR OR LOT WORK

Most work to the exterior of your house or lot requires approval from the Board of Directors. Application forms are on the website (arrowheadambler.org) and the turnaround time for a reply is usually less than one week. Check the Rules and Regulations (copy on website under Residents) for what requires approval.
